The College Western Band made a superlative performance was also joined by members of the Peterite Ensemble, a new group of ex Peterite musicians who have gathered to keep their comradery alive through music.

The fact that they comprised of a forty voice strong choir was a notable fact, with representation from teachers and masters from both the primary and college sections. The Peterite Chorale, comprising of past Peterite choristers, with it's rich blend of mature voices performed a diverse range of carols from Acapella to popular Sinhalese carols.

The last segment of the program was the combined effort of the Peterite Choir, the Peterite Western Band, The Chorale, the Peterite Ensemble and Teachers' Choir performing together.

To sum up the evening's events, Rev Fr Rohitha Rodrigo our Rector, thanked all who had participated in the event, and also extended his thanks to the congregation who had assembled in great numbers to participate in this event. In closing, the combined choirs performed the Christmas classic "Silent night", whilst they exited the chapel in procession, to regroup outside the front of the chapel and joined with the College Western band to share the Christmas cheer by singing a few more secular Christmas songs before dispersing into the night which was enjoyed by the massive crowd who had gathered at St Peter's.
