87-92 Batch Group


As the Centenary started, given the challenge all have faced due to Covid and the economic crisis, the batch group decided that the projects should be mainly targeted to help the needy given the circumstances and, should not be centered around entertainment only. With this primary objective in mind, the batch group was able to conduct many charity projects while ensuring some of the traditional batch group events were conducted throughout the year.

PROJECT AT KANDANA PARISH

The batch group organized a charity event on 25 th. June 2022 at the St Sebastian Church in Kandana by donating 50 parcels amounting to a value of LKR 400,000/-

PROJECT AT MORATUWA

On a collective request from Prof. Agaladada Sirisumana, Chief priest in Moratuwa and also, the head of the Sinhala division at the University of Colombo, to conduct a Medical camp for the People of the area, the batch group agreed to take up the project. On another request by the community from Moratuwa, the batch organized a Medical camp on 17 th September 2022 at Sri Bodhirajaramaya. With the help of NHSL, a comprehensive medical check-up was done and free spectacles and medicines too were given out. Free food (B'fast and lunch) was provided to the people of the area.

COMMITTEE ANNUAL OUTING

The batch had its outing on 29 th. October 2022 at Wadduwa Beach Hotel. The Committee members along with their families participated.

DENIYAYA PROJECT ON 03rd. DECEMBER 2022

Based on the success of the previous 2 projects in Kadana and Moratuwa. The committee decided on taking on another project in the rural area. Deniyaya was identified as a needy location due to the poor health facility, Malnutrition and remoteness. Over 1,000 registered for the camp. The cost of the project was over LKR 1 million where free healthcare services were provided. Dry rations too were distributed to around 200 needy people.

TEACHERS' OUTING

On the request of the OBU President Mr Ravika De Silva LKR 50,000/- was donated to meet the expenses with the approval of the committee.

ANNUAL HEALTH CAMP FOR TEACHERS PAST & PRESENT

The Batch group assisted the Health Committee in organizing the above event. This was done in 2 stages. About 300 teachers and staff members benefited from this project.

MEDICAL CENTRE AWARDS NIGHT

The members of the 87-92 helped the Health Committee in organizing the awards night which was held on 10th December 2022. Parallel to this event, the batch group found sponsors to meet the cost of the Plaque, Snacks etc. and donated a fridge, Nebulizers, an Oxygen regulator, and a Digital BP meter. The total cost was approx. LKR 450,000/-. Dr. Ajith Perera of Medichecks (Pvt) Ltd. was a main contributor to this event.

HELPING HAND PROJECT

In December 2022, the batch group launched a project to help needy batch mates during the festival season by collecting LKR 199,795.16 which was donated by each batch to the needy.

PREPARATION OF SNACKS FOR GRADE 01 STUDENTS

Based on a request made by the OBU to provide milk and thriposha for the students, the 87-92 batch sponsored this need and the cost was estimated at LKR 60,000/-

HI MATCHAN

Traditionally, the 87-92 Hi Matchan batch get-together event took place on 12th May 2023 at Mount Lavinia Beach at the Haus Chandra Beach hotel with around 106 participants which was the highest ever participation rate.


2004 Batch Group

In light of the centenary year, the 2004 batch group donated Rs. 300,000/- to various College and OBU activities and causes.






2006 Batch Group





 - o Memorial service for the war heroes In planning stage








D J Nicholas Perera Hall Project Committee

The Centenary year hall renovation project subcommittee was originally formed in 2021 to coordinate between the College administration and the OBU regarding Centenary year activities. With the activities in the Centenary curtailed due to the economic crisis faced in 2022, the sub committee extended its support on the Centenary celebrations day (18th January 2022) as well as, the development of the Centenary logo and the Centenary year song ("Golden Glories" by The Peterite Chorale).

Subsequently, the activities of the sub committee were focused towards the main fund-raising project undertaken by the OBU for the Centenary year; the D J Nicholas Perera Hall renovation project. The sub committee completed the following activities towards this project;

- □ Development of an initial scope assessment and estimated cost proposal – July 2021
- □ Development of sponsor/donation proposal and circulation November 2021
- □ Development of dedicated web page (on the OBU site) for donations along with updated donor details and payment gateway September 2022 https://stpetersobu.com/dj-nicholas-perera-hall-projec








FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE


- ► The Objective of the Finance Sub-committee is to enhance the visibility of the finance function of the St. Peter's College Old Boys' Union by maintaining transparency in finances.
- ▶ During the Financial Year 2022/23 the committee was involved with the finalization and submission of the Golden Gleam 2022 special purpose audit in line with the policies of the OBU. A RFP was floated among the identified audit firms and after evaluation, engagement was assigned to W.R Rodrigo & Co. to conduct the special purpose audit to validate the income and expenses of Golden Gleam 2022.
- ► Finance Committee ratified the special projects Budgets:
- ☐ Back to School
- ☐ Memorabilia: After reviewing, the budget with the project chair, due to adverse economic circumstances, the finance committee recommended to reduce the number of memorabilia items to 25 in the first phase.



FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE

- ▶ The Finance Committee reviewed and commented on the OPSC financials in relation to the consistency of presenting cost information in line with Sri Lanka Accounting Standards and agreed to align the cost/income presentation in line with the relevant accounting standards.
- ▶ The Finance Committee TOR was finalised and updated by the current finance committee to be included in the OBU constitution during the constitution amendment process. Even though the Finance committee existed prior to the constitutional reforms, the constitution did not incorporate the TOR of the finance committee.
- Finance committee ratified the preliminary budget submitted for Golden Gleam 2023 by the committee and raised observations relating to the budgeted profits and the allocation of profits. The Committee is in the process of finalising the budget.
- ▶ The Finance committee ratified the budget for the Peterite Stag Night and provided preliminary comments in providing a detailed break-up relating to income and expenditure items and this was later incorporated and submitted for approval.

FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE

The Finance Sub-committee was able to successfully achieve its objectives during the past year by enhancing the visibility of the finance function of the St. Peter's College Old Boys' Union by maintaining transparency in finances. The committee took the lead in reviewing, finalizing and ratifying all projects executed by the OBU and its affiliated entities.



Annual Health Camp for Past & Present Teachers
















Old Boys' Union House (OBUH) / The Peterite Lounge Sub Committee




The OPSC subcommittee concentrated on three major events during the Centenary year which is presented here.


Arts Foundation







- Operational support food supplied for full day practice sessions, indoor court bookings arranged at Sugathadasa indoor and other basketball courts to help prepare for the tournament.


